PARADE

Autumn Vegetable Soup Serving Size: 1/2 Cup Prop Time: 25 Minutes Total Time: 1 Haur

Ingredients:

- 1 Tablespoon olive oil
- 3 medium carrots, cut into 1/4inch slices
- 1 large yellow onion, diced
- · 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 medium sweet potato, cut into 1/2-inch cubes
- 1/4 teaspoon allspice
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon dried basil

- 1 quart (32-ounces) lowsodium chicken broth
- 1 (14.5-ounce) can no salt added diced tomatoes
- 1 1/2 teaspoons dried thyme or 4 sprigs fresh thyme
- 2 cups coarsely chopped collards or kale
- 1 (15.5-ounce_ can lowsodium chickpeas (garbanzo beans)
- Dash of red pepper flakes (optional)

Directions:

- 1. In a large saucepan, heat olive oil over medium heat.
- 2.Add diced carrots and onions and cook for about 5-6 minutes.
- 3. Add garlic and cook for an additional minute.
- 4. Add sweet potato, allspice, black pepper, and basil. Stir.
- 5. Add broth, tomatoes with their juice, and thyme.
- Bring to a boil, reduce heat to medium, cover and simmer for 10 minutes.
- Add collards or kale and chickpeas and cook uncovered until sweet potatoes are tender and kale is wilted, and 10 minutes.
- 8. If using fresh thyme sprigs, discard prior to serving.
